

DRONE APPLICATION FORM KATOWICE AIRPORT (EPKT)



The information provided below constitutes the minimum content required to obtain approval from the airport operator to conduct an unmanned aerial vehicle (UAV/drone) flight within the airport area. Additional information may be included in the form of a descriptive outline of the planned flight. The form should be completed and sent to the Airport Operations Duty Officer – dop@gtl.com.pl with copies to the Safety Manager – mstanek@gtl.com.pl, the Airport Security Operations Shift Supervisor (WSO) – sol@gtl.com.pl, the Terminal Coordinator – koordynator@gtl.com.pl and the Border Guard – sdo.katowice@strazgraniczna.pl. 5	Check the applicable boxes: (Required) I hereby declare that, as the operator of an unmanned aircraft (drone), I undertake to: a. exercise due care and avoid any action or omission that could: 1. endanger safety, including the safety of air traffic; 2. impede air traffic operations; 3. disturb public peace or order; 4. expose any person to harm; b. operate the unmanned aircraft in a manner that enables the avoidance of collisions with other aircraft; c. ensure that the unmanned aircraft used for the flight gives way to manned aircraft at all times; d. accept full responsibility for the decision to conduct the flight and for its proper execution; the designation and participation of an observer during flight operations do not relieve me of responsibility for the safety of the conducted aviation operations; e. operate the unmanned aircraft and control equipment in accordance with the manufacturer's recommendations and limitations, where such recommendations and limitations have been published; f. carry out a pre-flight inspection of the technical condition of the unmanned aircraft; g. conduct flights only with an airworthy and technically serviceable unmanned aircraft; h. hold a valid drone operator qualification certificate; i. possess safe flight operation procedures and emergency procedures (Operations Manual), j. hold a certificate confirming completion of training in operational rules and procedures relevant to the functioning of Katowice Airport; k. demonstrate proficiency in the Polish language, where communication with TWR is required; l. maintain communication capability with TWR and the Airport Operations Duty Officer. (Required) I hereby declare that I bear full responsibility for the accuracy, correctness, and truthfulness of the information provided in this application. (Optional) I hereby declare that, should I not meet the requirements regarding the certificate of completion of training in the operational rules and procedures of the airport or the required language proficiency, I will conduct operations under the supervision and assistance of a duly qualified person holding the appropriate certificates and authorizations. (Required) I confirm that I have read and understood the information regarding the data controller, the purpose and legal basis of data processing, and my rights related to the processing of personal data. Information Notice:

Pursuant to Articles 13 and 14 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation, hereinafter referred to as the "GDPR"), we hereby inform you that:

1. The data controller is Górnośląskie Towarzystwo Lotnicze S.A., Al. Korfanteogo 38, 40-161 Katowice, Poland.
2. Purpose of personal data processing: issuing authorization for the operation of an unmanned aircraft (drone) within the airport area.
Scope of personal data processing: full name, e-mail address, and telephone number.
3. Recipients of personal data: employees of Górnośląskie Towarzystwo Lotnicze S.A., entities and public authorities to whom the data may be disclosed under applicable laws, as well as service providers involved in data access and processing, including IT, hosting, postal, courier, legal, and auditing service providers.
4. You have the right to access your personal data and to request its rectification.
5. Data are processed pursuant to Article 6(1)(f) of the GDPR, based on the legitimate interests pursued by the data controller and arising from the following regulations:
 - Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2019/947 of 24 May 2019 on the rules and procedures for the operation of unmanned aircraft, Article 15(1)-(2);
 - Polish Aviation Law Act of 3 July 2003, Article 87;
 - Commission Regulation (EU) No 139/2014 of 12 February 2014 laying down requirements and administrative procedures related to aerodromes, point ADR.OR.D.075.
6. Your personal data will be retained for a period of five (5) years in accordance with ADR.OR.D.035(d) concerning record-keeping requirements,
7. Providing personal data is voluntary; however, failure to provide the required data will make it impossible to process the application,
8. You have the right to request the erasure of your personal data, restriction of processing, and data portability,
9. You also have the right to object to the processing of your personal data,
