

TEMPORARY OBJECT APPLICATION FORM KATOWICE AIRPORT (EPKT)



The information provided below, together with a map indicating the location of the proposed object, constitutes the minimum information required to conduct a height assessment of the object in relation to the airport's obstacle limitation surfaces. If the object is determined to constitute an aeronautical obstacle or otherwise pose a hazard to aircraft operations, the Airport Operations Duty Officer will issue a NOTAM to notify flight crews and other parties involved in aviation operations. This notification may be supplemented with a more detailed description of the location. The form should be completed and submitted to the Airport Operations Duty Officer – dop@gtl.com.pl with copies to: Jakub Segal – jsegal@gtl.com.pl and the Safety Manager – mstanek@gtl.com.pl. For objects that constitute an aeronautical obstacle or significantly affect the safety of flight operations, the entity applying for the placement of a temporary object must obtain coordination from PANSa regarding its impact on flight procedures. Detailed instructions and the application form are available on the PANSa website: www.pansa.pl/przeszkody-lotnicze/

The decision as to whether coordination with PANSa is required shall be made by the Airport Operations Duty Officer.
